

# Download Guess My Number 100 Chart

IDEA 1: Hundreds Chart Warm Up Activities Warm Up Activity #1: How Far Apart? Provide each student with two chips or counters and a copy of a 100 chart. First highlight an important number to you. For example, my number would be 6 because it represents the 6th month of the year, which is June (the month I was born). 100 chart. Player 2 keeps asking Player 1 yes or no questions about the number. Keep track of the number of questions it takes to guess Player 1's number. Try to guess in as few questions as possible. Take turns being Player 1 and Player 2. More Ways to Play Play with a small group. Guess My Number works equally well with fractions, decimals, or percents. Giving the students some visual tools is essential. Using a number line helps students compare numbers and order the numbers. A 1–100 chart is another tool that works nicely for Guess My Number.
