The International Style is a major architectural style that was developed in the 1920s and 1930s and was closely related to modernism and modern architecture. It was first defined by Museum of Modern Art curators Henry-Russell Hitchcock and Philip Johnson in 1932, based on works of architecture from the 1920s. It is defined by the Getty Research Institute as "the style of architecture that ...Latin American architecture - Postindependence, c. 1810–the present: The domination of Spain by Napoleon accelerated a period of revolution from about 1810 to 1870. By the mid-19th century most of Latin America was independent of Spain, which produced a reaction against 300 years of Spanish rule and the pervasive Baroque architecture it had popularized. Western architecture - Late 19th-century developments: The Industrial Revolution in Britain introduced new building types and new methods of construction. Marshall, Benyou, and Bage's flour mill (now Allied Breweries) at Ditherington, Shropshire (1796–97), is one of the first iron-frame buildings, though brick walls still carry part of the load and there are no longitudinal beams.
